Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 131, Section 40 provides: "Whoever violates any provision of this section (a) hall be punished by a fine of not more than twenty-five thousand dollars or by imprisonment for not nore than two years, or both, such fine and imprisonment; or (b) shall be subject to a civil penalty not be exceed twenty-five thousand dollars for each violation". Each day or portion thereof of continuing iolation shall constitute a separate offense.
