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C. Appeals

The applicant, the owner, any person aggrieved by this Notification, any owner of land abutting the land upon which the proposed work is to done, or any ten residents of the city or town in which such land is located, are hereby notified of their right to appeal this decision to the appropriate DEP Regional Office (see http://www.mass.gov/dep/about/region/findyour.htm). This request must be made by certified mail or hand delivery to DEP, with the appropriate filing fee and a completed Request for Departmental Action Fee Transmittal Form, as provided in 310 CMR 10.03(7) within ten business days from the date of issuance of this Notification. A copy of the request shall at the same time be sent by certified mail or hand delivery to the Conservation Commission and to the applicant, if he/she is not the appellant. The request should state clearly and concisely the objections to this Notification which is being appealed and how this Notification does not contribute to the protection of the interests identified in the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act, (M.G.L. c. 131, § 40).

To the extent that the Notification is based on a municipal ordinance or bylaw, and not on the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act or regulations, the Department has no appellate jurisdiction.

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D. Recording Confirmation

Prior to commencement of work, the applicant is responsible for ensuring that this Notification of Non-Significance is recorded in the Registry of Deeds or the Land Court for the district in which the land is located, within the chain of title of the affected property. In the case of recorded land, it shall be noted in the Registry's Grantor Index under the name of the owner of the land upon which the proposed work is done. In the case of registered land, it shall also be noted on the Land Court Certificate of Title of the owner upon which the proposed work is done. This form must be stamped by the Registry of Deeds.
